

PanCare Data Protection and Privacy Policy

PanCare Society maintains a database that contains personal data of PanCare members, and participants in PanCare events.

This document details what personal data PanCare maintains, how the data is collected, stored and protected and the purposes for which it is used. It also gives information on the rights of individual data subjects.

The Data Protection and Privacy Policy (hereafter referred to as „Policy“) complies with the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679).

Personal data entrusted to us is treated as confidential and protected at all times.

What personal data is collected and why

PanCare collects only such data that we need to be able to contact PanCare members, collaborators and supporters to pass on relevant information and manage PanCare membership. The data we collect and maintain is limited to name, email address, phone number, and affiliation (institution/employer). We also keep records of whether individual subjects are survivors, parents of survivors, professionals or other. This information is necessary to select an appropriate membership fee and pass on relevant information. Due to the sensitivity of categories of members this data is visible only to the PanCare Board, unless the member gives her/his permission to make it visible to other for other PanCare members.

During the conferences and events we organize we may take photographs. By registering to our events, attendees agree that photographs taken during these events may be posted on our website, in our newsletter, social media or similar.

How is personal data obtained

The data is collected through PanCare membership application form, PanCare events registration forms and email communication.

How is personal data used and stored

PanCare ensures that all personal data under its responsibility is used solely to contact PanCare members, collaborators and supporters in relevant matters (e.g. information emails, newsletter distribution) and to manage PanCare membership (set appropriate

membership fee levels, pass relevant information). Individual subjects may unsubscribe from PanCare mailings or request their personal data removal at any time by using PanCare contact details below.

The data is stored in an electronic database and protected by safeguards that ensure appropriate security and access control.

PanCare will not sell, distribute, lease or share any personal data under its responsibility with any third parties.

Control over the processed data by the data subjects

The data subjects have the right to:

- access information on their processed personal data; PanCare members can access their data by signing into the Members Area on the PanCare website (<https://www.pancare.eu/en/member/>). Non-members can contact us at info@pancare.eu to request detailed information about their personal data.
- request that their personal data be modified or corrected;
- request that their personal data be completely and permanently erased from the PanCare database;
- request that they be unsubscribed from our mailing lists or choose to receive only specific information
